


CLIPSREEL TUTORIAL- How To Create Video By Copying And Pasting Your Content



Follow these simple steps below:

1. In order to create video in ClipsReel by copying and pasting your content, click on “Create Video” tab present on the left side of screen.




2. Click “Copy & Paste Your Content” then enter or paste your content. You will automatically create a story and bring you to storyboard customization window where you can customize the video.

Note: To separate story you can use [CLIPSREEL] as separator for multiple lines in your story board.




3. Customization Tools

- Campaign Name-** Enter the name of the campaign you wish. You can still change it later on.
- Resolution-** it refers quality of your video. You can choose from the drop down according to your preference.
- Render As-** here you can choose the format for your video. It can either be an MP4 or GIF.




4. Editing Tools


- Story-** To start creating your video, kindly click on text area on image and edit your content accordingly.




- Text-** This allows you to edit the text properties such as the font size, font style, text color, and position.




- c. **Media-** this tab is where you can search for a pre-uploaded image/video and also lets you upload your own.




- d. **Audio-** this is where you can add music to your video. You can use the pre-uploaded ones or upload your own. It also has a text to speech feature you can insert to your video.




- e. **Style-** this is where you can add/remove a watermark, add a logo, insert video frames and some graphics to add life to your video.



- f. **Credits**- this is where you can add an introduction and an ending credits to your video.



5. Once you're done editing your video, click on **Publish Video** on the upper righthand corner or if you don't want to publish it yet and want to continue editing it, click on Save & Edit Later.



6. You can see your created videos on the Manage Videos tab on the app dashboard.
